

Psycho-socio-epidemiological study of suicidal feelings in a sample of Egyptian students

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The results of this study revealed significant differences between the students studying the scientific or literal subjects regarding the prevalence of suicidal feelings. Most of these feelings are of minor degree. But the attempted suicide overpresented among those studying scientific subjects. The most common suicidal attempts were through drug overdose followed by self-injury. The most common cause of suicidal feelings was the emotional problems followed by the scholastic problems, then the financial reasons. The single status, lack of understanding between siblings, insomnia, depressed mood, forgetfulness, somatic symptoms and visit the physician are all risk factors of suicidal feelings
