Domestic violence is a sizable problem among married women. The ecological framework of the problem is complex and multifactorial. Among a sample of 400 women, domestic violence was more common in circumcised women and those who have more daughters. It was found that the problem was more common also among wives whose husbands were easily tempered and were exposed to physical violence during their childhood.
