

Personality assessment of male children with child sexual abuse in Sharkia Governorate

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The objective of this work was to study the prevalence of child sexual abuse (CSA) among sample of population (male person) and also to assess the personality.

The samples of the study constituted 300 individuals interviewed by sex hospital questionnaire (MHQ) to assess their personality. The prevalence of child sexual abuse (CSA) of the sample was 16% (before age of 12 years) and also those persons scored pathological levels in anxiety depression somatic and hysterical scales of middle sex hospital questionnaire (MHQ) than those who did not.

The study concluded that the personality of the male persons who have child sexual abuse (CSA) was pathologically affected in comparable with those who did not, and these populations need medical and social help.
