case group suffer from depression, anxiety more than control group.

patients below 50 years old suffer severe symptoms of anxiety,

Depression more than those above 50 years old.

Quality of life is worse in patients below 50 years.

More anxiety is present in patients with lumpectomy (for fear of recurrence).

More depression is present in patients with radical mastectomy.

There are cultural issues that need to be assessed in breast-cancer patients so we suggest some questions added to quality of life tools.
