

Psychiatric morbidity in infertility in a sample of Egyptian females

Infertile women need psychiatric help.

Review medical aspects of infertility and review available treatment of psychiatric difficulties related to infertility.

PCASEE quality of life questionnaire.

Eysenck Personality Questionnaire (E.P.Q) D- scale of Guilford Inventory of Personality factors.

Fahmy and El-Sherbini Social Classification Scale .

Social phobia is the most encountered ,followed by dysthymia, major depressive disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder, agoraphobia and post traumatic stress disorder.

Comorbidity between depression and anxiety is high.

High prevalence of personality disorder.

Women with psychiatric morbidity have difficulty to become pregnant and poorer outcome in general.
