

Presentation of female sexual dysfunction in medical practice

To detect relative frequency, forms and possible psychological factors of sexual dysfunction. Case-control study (comparative study) Tools used were: General sexual screen proposed by Sheehan. Semistructured interview tailored to fit the research, diagnose sexual problems according to ICD 10. Marital Satisfaction Inventory (global version) .DSFI (Derogates sexual functioning inventory). Conservative patients: (30 year old-from suburban areas-have more than 3 children-unwanted pregnancy-after 10 years of contraception) Frank cases (20 years old-newly married-no children-liberal-positive self body image-first 3 years of marriage-after any gynecological operation). Most common sexual complaints were vaginismus, loss of sexual desire, dyspareunia and anorgasmia.
