

Interpersonal communication pattern as perceived by nursing students in their clinical training

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The aim of this study was to assess the faculty Staff interpersonal communication pattern as perceived by the nursing students in their clinical training from the students point of view. The study was conducted at the Faculty of Nursing, Ain Shams University, covering students at the different nursing departments (452): Fundamentals, medical surgical, pediatric, obstetric, community and public health and psychiatric mental health nursing.

Data were collected through an opinionnaire describing the characteristics of the study sample which includes: age, sex, year of study and department and an open ended questions, related to students views in points. The study recommended holding conferences and training workshops with staff members for discussing teacher' awareness and solving communication problems.
