

## **An epidemiological study of conduct disorder in primary schoolchildren**

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The aim for To survey the prevalence of conduct disorders in primary school children as well as clinical pattern and etiological factors. A sample of 425 primary school students from 3 primary schools using Draw a man Test and psychiatric Questionnaire The prevalence of conduct disorder was 6.35% in children, while the prevalence of oppositional defiant disorder was 2.13 %. Conduct disorder is distressing problem in both developed and developing countries. Both biological and social factors contribute and predispose to conduct disorder. Also the psychological factors especially relationship between mother and child predispose to such disorder.
