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The aim of this study is to detect the prevalence of social anxiety disorder and symptoms in a sample of Egyptian children To detect the prevalence of comorbid symptoms of psychiatric disorders in the sample A sample consists of 800 age school children selected from five governmental schools in El Sharkia using Children Anxiety Scale and 63.1% using Fear Questionnaire.
